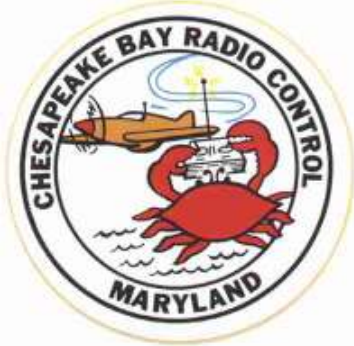


Crabrag
